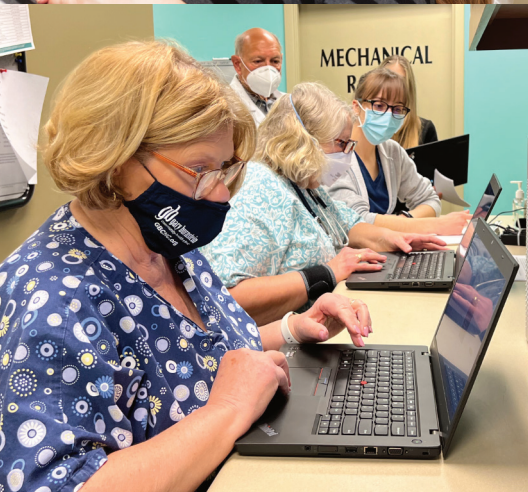

# Your Support Expanded Services for Uninsured Adults in 2021

- We received a three-year CDC grant through the State of Michigan to provide **COVID-19 vaccinations, boosters, and education** to Oakland County residents. Kywona Bernard, NP, is leading this project both at the Clinic and in the community.
- We began to expand our **behavioral health program** to include one-to-one therapy, thanks to an Oakland Together grant from the **United Way for Southeastern Michigan**.
- Monica Mirariu joined us in the new position of **staff pharmacist** thanks to the **Vera and Joseph Dresner Foundation and the Lisa and Jonathan Zirin Family**, providing \$1.5 million in medications to our patients in 2021.
- We added **optometry and glasses** to our list of specialty services thanks to **Stanley Grandon and Aaron Rosberg** for the optical equipment, and **Jessica Jacques Goodman**, our volunteer optometrist.
- Our **dental program** expanded!
  - Two new dental rooms were added for a total of five;
  - Partnerships with the **University of Michigan** School of Dentistry and **Oakland Community College** Hygienist School helped us serve more patients and train future dentists on the importance of community health services;
  - We received **generous support** from the Vera and Joseph Dresner Foundation, Delta Dental Foundation, Michigan Dental Association Foundation, Sieg Dunlap Foundation, and **hundreds of #GivingTuesday donors like you** to cover costs from fillings to dentures.



# 2021 in Numbers:

- 1,246 patients for 4,410 appointments for an average of 3.5 appointments per patient.
- Medical: 2,379 (54%) appointments, 550 patients (44%).
- Dental: 2,031 (46%) appointments, 696 patients (56%)  
\$1 million worth of dental services provided at no cost to the patients.
- Pharmacy: 5,008 prescriptions, 538 patients averaging 10 prescriptions each. \$1.5 million worth of prescriptions provided at no cost to the patients.

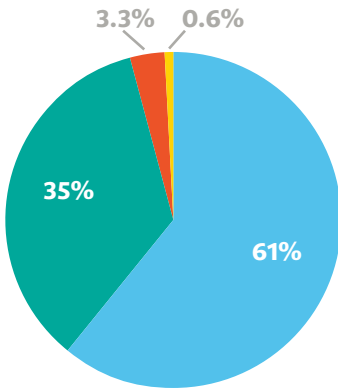

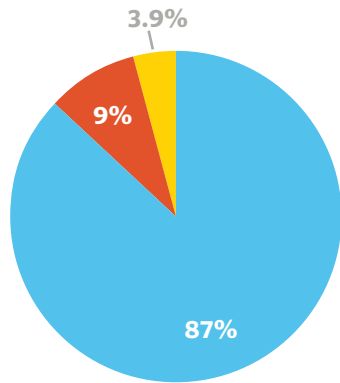
