I think my dad healed not only their physical ailments, but helped to heal their souls. He would listen and laugh with the patients. He was a kind and gentle man to those who knew him, the kind who would literally give you the shirt off his back or the shoes off his feet. He never expected anything or wanted anything in return, certainly not his name on a building."

The Vera and Joseph Dresner Foundation Invests in the GBCHC Dental Program


